

## 2020-2021 PE and Sport Premium Review

## **Funding**

Funding rate: £8,000 (doubled this year) + £10 per pupil = £17,570

## Objectives of the spending in the PE grant are:

- Increased engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity
- Raise the profile of PE and sport across the school
- Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of staff in teaching PE
- Broaden the sporting opportunity available to pupils
- Increased participation in competitive sport

## Breakdown of spending

Due to the situation regarding COVID19, we have decided to rollover half of the funding into the following year as we were unable to put many of our plans into action.
