WHAT IS IT?

Pupil premium is **additional funding** for our school to ensure we can support all pupils to achieve their best.

REMEMBER ...

- Register all your children
- Apply at any time if your circumstances change
- Once eligible, your child will receive funding for the next 6 years

You can still apply even if your child has packed lunches or is in R, Y1 or Y2

- **Funded** school trips
- **Free** access to clubs
- **Free** access to fundraising events

- Access to **free** local holiday activities

HOW DO I APPLY?

For funding this year, applications need completing before 1st October

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Your child may be eligible if you receive income support, jobseeker's allowance, employment and support allowance, universal credit, asylum seeker support, child tax credit, working tax credit, or state pension.
