- Trusting God (Isaiah 49.16)

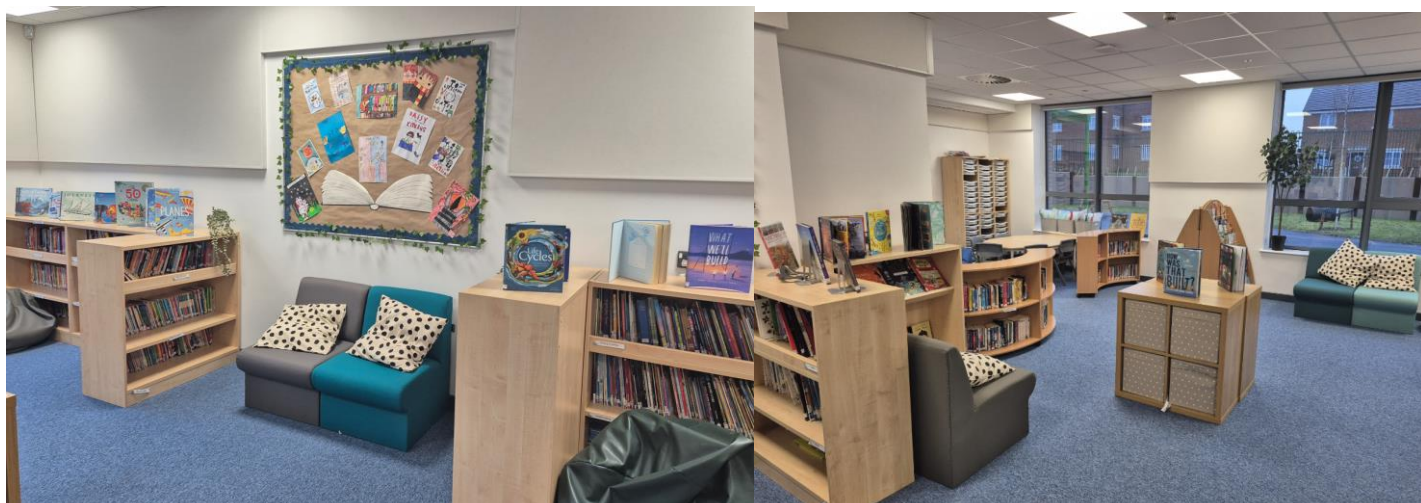
Advent service

Reception have created a wonderful stable as their role play area this term. The children enjoy using this space.

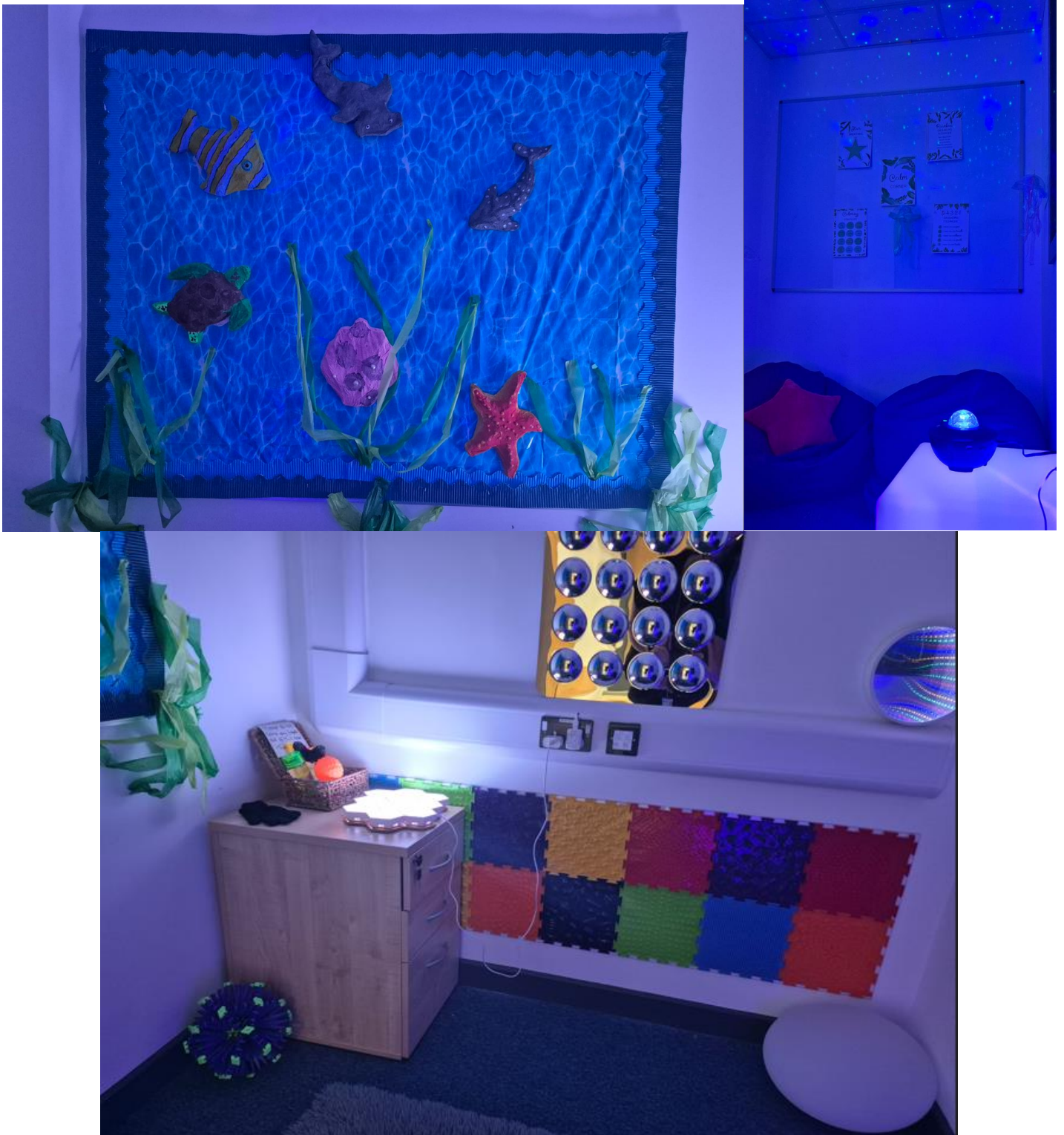
The children in The Haven have created their own displays; Be Kind, Winter, Thoughts and Sunflowers.
