Phonics

All parents/carers of children in Reception and Year 1 are invited to a phonics workshop to gain a better understanding of phonics and how you can best support your child with reading at home.

What is phonics?

Phonics is making connections between the sounds of our spoken words and the letters that are used to write them down. We use a phonics programme called Little Wandle throughout EYFS and Key Stage 1 to teach reading and the spelling of words.

We look forward to welcoming you into school for a short presentation on how we teach phonics and reading at Shrivenham followed by an opportunity to play phonics games with your child in their classroom.

Driving and Parking

You may have seen our no parking people near the pavements. We are working with the parish council to have more cones to place along the path. This is because it is a risk to pedestrians when cars are mounting the paths even when families are walking alongside it. As I said last week, the children's safety is our priority.
