We kindly ask that you review our school's uniform expectations to ensure your child is appropriately dressed each day. This includes uniform items, appropriate footwear, and any guidelines related to hair, jewellery, and accessories. In September the school uniform will be:

School Uniform:

- Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan with or without the school logo
- White or blue polo shirt – **this is the same colour blue as the jumper – not pale blue**
- Grey trousers / shorts / dress / skirts / culottes
- Blue and white gingham dress for (late spring/summer)
- Plain white / black / grey socks
- Black shoes
- Shrivenham blue fleece – only to be worn outside – this is not as a replacement for a jumper or cardigan



PE Kit:

- Plain black or navy shorts/skorts/leggings
- White T-Shirt
- Trainers
- Logos should be small and minimal
- Optional school logo Navy Hoody
- Navy tracksuit (jogging bottoms and jumper)



Our uniform provider is now selling Shrivenham School Hoodies for PE – these are Navy blue and are only permitted to wear on PE days unless otherwise instructed.
